Six Week Investigation leads to arrest of York City Man

York, PA – During the late afternoon hours of Tuesday, June 12, 2018, York County Drug Task Force officers concluded a six week investigation which targeted Johnathan Jesus Acevedo, age 25, of 752 Colony Rd. Through the course of their investigation, officers determined that Acevedo was distributing cocaine at various locations throughout York City. Undercover officers were able to purchase multi-gram quantities of cocaine from him on several occasions during this six week investigation.

On June 12, Drug Task Force members with the assistance of York City Patrol officers arrested Acevedo after he left his residence. At the time of his arrest Acevedo was in possession of several grams of cocaine. A search warrant was served at his residence shortly thereafter, resulting in the seizure of approximately 110 grams of cocaine, \$2,400 cash, drug distribution paraphernalia and Acevedo's 2006 Lexus coupe.

Acevedo was charged with cocaine distribution offenses and committed to the York County Prison in lieu of bail.

"This investigation is another example of our Drug Task Force's dedication to working with each of our municipal police departments to rid our community of those involved in selling illegal narcotics," said District Attorney Dave Sunday. "Furthermore, I would like to specifically thank the York City Police Department for their assistance in the investigation and arrest of Acevedo," said Sunday.

Criminal charges, and any discussion thereof, are merely allegations and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
