Cold Case Update on Body Located in West Manchester Township in 2013

York, PA – The West Manchester Township Police Department has partnered with two colleges in an effort to identify the skeletal remains that were discovered in 2013 near the West Manchester Mall. Penn State Universities Digital Fabrication & Specialized Technologies Department assisted with 3D scanning and 3D printing of the victims' skull, which would then allow police to have a forensic artist construct a 3D model of the victim. Penn State Forensic Artist Jenny Kenyon will be constructing a 3D model of the victim in addition to an age regression sketch of the victim which aims to depict how the victim would have looked in his younger years. We have also solicited the assistance of the University of Arizona and Dr. Greg Hodgins. Dr. Hodgins will be assisting with Carbon 14 dating as it relates to the teeth, with the hopes of allowing police to narrow down the year of birth for the victim.

The West Manchester Township Police Department along with the assistance of the York County District Attorney's Office is committed to using each and every tool available to them in order to identify this victim. It is with this latest testing which renews our hope, that an identification will be made, the victims remains will be returned to the family and if possible an arrest in this cold case homicide. The West Manchester Township Police Department continues to use cutting edge technology and advanced testing to bring this investigation to a close.
