FUGITIVE WANTED ON ATTEMPTED HOMICIDE CHARGE ARRESTED IN YORK CITY

York, PA – During the early afternoon hours of Thursday, April 4, 2019 members of the York County Drug Task Force, U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force, York County Sheriff's Office and the York City Police Department arrested Infinite Ka Corbett in the 200 block of Jefferson St., York City, after he delivered a quantity of heroin and oxycodone to Drug Task Force officers. Corbett was taken into custody after a short foot pursuit. When arrested, Corbett was found to be in possession of a stolen handgun.

Corbett had been charged by York City Police, in September 2018, with Attempted Homicide and Aggravated Assault.

District Attorney Dave Sunday said, "Corbett's arrest was the second high profile arrest by local law enforcement and members of the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force in less than 24 hours." "The arrests of Dion-Taye Jackson and Infinite Corbett, highlight our relentless pursuit of those seeking to elude justice as well as our desire to purge our streets of those possessing and selling illegal narcotics and firearms," said Sunday.

Corbett was charged with Drug Delivery offenses, Receiving Stolen Property and Firearms offenses. He was committed to the York County Prison in lieu of bail.

Criminal charges, and any discussion thereof, are merely allegations and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
