Baltimore Man Arrested and Charged for Attempting to Deliver Heroin in the City of York

York, PA – On Friday, February 28, detectives assigned to the York County Drug Task Force along with officers from the York City Police Department arrested 54 year old Howard Lee Campbell of Baltimore, Maryland, after he arrived at a convenience store located in the north end of York City. During the course of the investigation, detectives developed information that Campbell would be arriving that day with a quantity of heroin to be transferred to another person.

Shortly after 3:00 pm that afternoon, Campbell was observed arriving at the location in a 2015 Nissan Altima. Campbell was taken into custody shortly thereafter without incident. A search of his vehicle resulted in the discovery of 195 capsules of heroin, weighing approximately 200 grams.

Campbell was charged with Possession with the Intent to Deliver Heroin and taken to the York County Judicial Center for processing.

District Attorney Dave Sunday said, "This arrest serves as an excellent reminder that the distribution of illegal narcotics knows no boundaries. We remain committed to working with our local, state, and federal law enforcement partners to stop the flow of drugs into our community."

Criminal charges, and any discussion thereof, are merely allegations and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
