North York Borough Tax Collector Charged

York, PA – On Wednesday, December 15, 2021, Detective Jeff Snell of the York County District Attorney's Office, filed two sets of unrelated charges against North York Borough Tax Collector, Keith Allen Ramsay.

Ramsay, of the 100 block of Olympia Ave. was charged with Harassment and Open Lewdness for sexually explicit text messages sent to a North York Borough council woman, the week of November 1, 2021. Following the incident, the victim was able to obtain a temporary protection from sexual violence order against Ramsay on November 22.

Additionally, Ramsay was charged with Tamper With/Fabricate Physical Evidence, Simple Assault and Disorderly Conduct for a shots fired call in June of 2020. It is alleged that Ramsay fired two (2) shots at, or in the direction of three individuals located in the Lebanon Cemetery. Ramsay then attempted to mislead police by cleaning up the scene and setting off fireworks.

"I would like to thank the York County Detective Bureau for its thorough and diligent investigation in this matter," said District Attorney Dave Sunday.

Criminal charges, and any discussion thereof, are merely allegations and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
